

Lesson 30 That Your Offspring May be Blessed

12/19/2010 MEETING: PRESENT – I AM, Bob and Cindy

CT – Respect and honor your King; that your offspring may be blessed.

You are my representative; have your actions reflect our relationship. Abandon bad habits. Spend time each week reflecting on your actions for that week. Are there areas you can improve in? Spend time with me to improve those areas. Short tempers, anger, frustration these feelings are not from Me. Get Satan out of the equation. Live Me. Be the person I created.

Alphabet soup (everything A to Z).. All that I created is at your fingertips. Grasp it, swallow it in; devour it for it is good. You should get encouragement just from observing my creation; seeing my work. I'm still at work you know. Take comfort in my forever presence with you. Equilibrium. Allow me to help keep you balanced. I saw something like a person on a see-saw with the person being on the down side with the other side of the see-saw empty and up in the air. It was like we are keeping our time with the Lord all in a small bit of time during the day; but He is wanting to be a part of our entire day balancing out the entire day making the see-saw level.

From last week's meeting:

BT – People must go to the Lord individually and He will work with each life.

Have your actions reflect our relationship.

Our relationship goal with The Lord is to become part of the married bride. This is what the Lord wants for us. But this requires refining (action) on our part. Our actions will reflect where we are in our relationship and our refining. Remember all of this is not about salvation unto eternal life; it is about coming into God's Kingdom the way He would like for you to. It is about why He said, "A passion for ME is not enough." But what does that mean? And then He said "Adherence to MY rules, MY way of doing things." Action. He is teaching us about the actions required on our part to become the married bride. He is teaching us about the actions required for refinement. That's what's important.

In a Jewish wedding the bride must go through a purification process before she can put on the gown. Likewise we must go through a purification process before we can put on the gown. This is because in a marriage two become one. Jesus is and has always been clean. Before we can enter into Him we likewise must be clean. So let's look at this purification process.

First, have you gotten rid of the three spots:

Confessing unto salvation, Tithing and Comparing spiritual to spiritual (keeping your journal) Where are each one of us on this journey? Have you decided to leave the harlot. Remember you cannot serve two masters. The Lord told Roy "I cannot make you the man I want you to be as long as you remain in the harlot."

The second part in the refining process involves having meetings correctly and following after the Lord's calendar not man's. It is important to understand at this point that we are seeking after the Lord's refinement of us not man's. That's why learning The Lord's way of doing things, being obedient to Him and discarding the traditions of man is so important.

Spend time each week reflecting on your actions for that week.

The Lord understands that this is a process of change you are going through. He is teaching us that each person is an individual. We might not all process these changes on the same timetable but He does work with each one of us. That is why He told us "People must go to the Lord individually and He will work with each life." He continued by saying, "Spend time each week reflecting on your actions for that week. Are there areas you can improve in? Spend time with me to improve those areas."

The Lord taught us during The Day of Atonement or "Yom Kippur" of the importance of reflection in the purification process. We have in fact learned that each holy day the Lord established (his calendar) teaches us of another step in our process of refinement. He is teaching us now that we should spend time each week reflecting on our actions. This is an indication I think of the importance of this part of your refinement.

Equilibrium. Allow me to help keep you balanced.

In Exodus 33:14 And He said, "My Presence will go with you, and I will give you rest." It is The Lord alone who truly keeps us balanced. He was showing us through the vision above that he wants to be a apart of our entire day, our entire life. He wants more than your devotion time, He wants more than your church time. He wants all of you. He wants you to allow Him to keep you balanced.

For some reason the word balanced jumped out at me so I decided to look up the meaning. Balance, balanced, balancing – 1)a: to compute the difference between the debits and credits of (an account); to pay the amount due; settle b:to arrange so that one set of elements exactly equal another 2) counterbalance, offset; to equal or equalize in weight, number or proportion 3) to weigh in or as in a balance 4) to bring to a state or position; to poise in or as if in balance; to bring into harmony. So The Lord is saying "Allow me to help keep you balanced" – allow me to help you pay the amount, allow me to help you offset the weight, allow me to help you live in harmony. And He said, "My Presence will go with you, and I will give you rest." It is amazing to me how he picks just the right words. Spend time with me to improve those areas." He is with us. He will give us rest. He will keep us balanced so that we can grow, purify, and become part of his bride.

As encouragement for this journey The Lord also reminded us of his creation. He said. Alphabet soup (everything A to Z).. All that I created is at your fingertips. Grasp it, swallow it in; devour it for it is good. You should get encouragement just from observing my creation; seeing my work. I'm still at work you know. Take comfort in my forever presence with you. We see the creation, the variety and vastness, of God's power, His work and we know My God is an awesome God. He is with me. There is nothing impossible for Him. He is working on me (I'm still at work you know). He is refining me. I am apart of His creation (Live Me). I can be the person he created. I can live in his will for me. I can Be the person HE created.
