I decided to focus on the unfettered path today but what is the unfettered path? I guess to understand the unfettered path we need to make sure we understand the definition of the root word fetter or fettered. Fettered – Definition: Restrained from motion, action or progress. Thus when looking at the unfettered path we will be looking at a path of progress and action. It is a path of motion and most importantly it is a path that is not restrained. Isaiah 35:8

And a highway shall be there, and a way, and it shall be called The way of holiness; the unclean shall not pass over it; but it shall be for those: the wayfaring men, though fools, shall not err therein.

Isaiah 35:1

The wilderness and the solitary place shall be glad for them; and the desert shall rejoice, and blossom as the rose.

2 Corinthians 11:1-3
