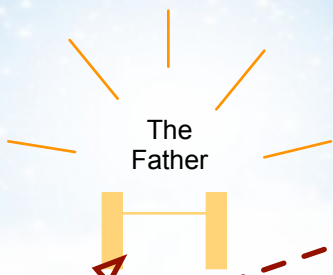


ETERNAL SALVATION

To Man, not to God!

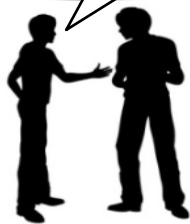
COVENANT PROMISE:

Jesus revealed the man was saved, yet the man had never been baptized in water, taken communion, or said a repeat after me prayer!

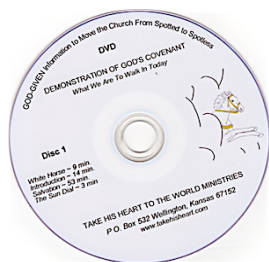
He was a thief! - But **SAVED**
