1st Spot - Salvation

This is the spot close to God's heart

In the following sections you will find demonstrations of what God taught, along with various pitfalls, of what we do as a corporate church body.

I SAW THE STRAIGHT GATE!

- Matt 7:14 *Because strait is the gate, and narrow is the way, which leads unto life, and few there be that find it.*
- Matt 7:21-23 *Not every one that says unto me, Lord, Lord shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that does the will of my Father which is in heaven. Many will say to me in that day, Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in thy name? and in thy name have cast devils/ and in thy name done many wonderful works? An then will I profess unto them, I never knew you: depart from me, ye that work iniquity.*
- Two truths -1. there is a problem in the doctrines of the churches which was forecasted in the Bible; 2. the way through the gate is extremely easy. No door at the gate which tells us clearly that the way is easy with no “works” involved on our part when it comes to eternal salvation. If we had to open the gate, we would have to work (do works).

GOD TOOK ME TO HEAVEN

- Confessing Christ before men. This is a covenant promise that reveals how you go through Him to obtain eternal life.
 - Matt 10:32 *Whosoever therefore shall confess me to men, him will I confess also to my Father which is in heaven.*

1st Spot (cont'd)

REPEAT AFTER ME'S DON'T WORK

- Only **YOU** can establish what you believe. (ex. Fred's pickled fish farm.) You may believe what they say but they are still **not your** words.
- Act 8:35-37 *Then Philip opened his mouth, and began at the same scripture, and preached unto him Jesus. And as they went on their way, they came unto a certain water: and the eunuch said, See, here is water; what does hinder me to be baptized? And Philip said, If thou believes with all thine heart, thou mayest. And he answered and said, I believe that Jesus Christ is the Son of God.* (No repeat after me's here!)
- When a person makes a choice between yes or no, they are establishing or denying the meaning of these words as their belief.

WHY ISN'T PRAYER THE VEHICLE OF CONFESSION FOR SALVATION?

- We need to see a pattern/principle how we establish things.
 - Matt 16:19 *And I will give thee the keys of the kingdom of heaven: and whatsoever thou shalt bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever thou shalt loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven.*
- The pattern is we establish something on earth and what we establish on earth moves God in Heaven.
- We see that what we are establishing is established with men.
 - Matt 6:14 & 15 *For if ye forgive men their trespasses, your heavenly father will also forgive you: but if your forgive not men their trespasses, neither will your father forgive your trespasses.*

1st Spot (cont'd)

- When we try to establish, or confess our belief directly to God through prayer, we are trying to bypass Jesus' covenant promise Matt 16:19. We can't establish anything directly in heaven ourselves.
- In Romans 10:6-13 Paul teaches the mechanics of working our faith to become saved.
- There is no judgement on God's part concerning your salvation. Your name is either written in heaven or it's not. Jesus is the only one who can write it there. It comes by your confession to another person, not works.
- The Lord your God is not a God of mutual agreements but a God of covenants. We are saved by covenant promise and that man had no input into how the covenant is established, or entered into, or what is contained in it.
- Mutual agreements are 2-sided and breakable. God's covenant promises are unbreakable even if both parties wanted out!
- Covenant is part of God's personality. His character!

1st Spot (cont'd)

SOME TO HONOR AND SOME TO DISHONOR

- 2Tim 2:19-21 This is not a license to break God's law. It is clearly stated in these scriptures that the Lord has called us to be vessels to honor, suitable for His use.
- We are to establish God's Laws Romans 3:31. We establish them by doing them.
- God calls us to walk upright before him, but sinning doesn't cause us to lose our eternal salvation.

WHAT MUST WE CONFESS

- Romans 10:9 - we need to establish who Jesus is in our confession.
- 1Tim 3:16 & 1John 4:2-3 - Jesus was God manifest in the flesh.

WHAT ABOUT WHEN SOMEONE ASKS HIM INTO THEIR HEART?

- Matt 7:21-23 We must realize that just because someone has God move in their life doesn't mean they are saved. God moves because that door was opened.

1st Spot (cont'd)

WHEN IS YOUR SPIRIT BORN AGAIN?

- John 3:5-7 You feel your spirit become born again by feeling a very faint shock, like a spark of electricity that goes through you. This is because you are a “spirit being” and this conversion of your spirit is real.
- 1John 4:15 this scripture reveals when your spirit is born again.

BAPTISM IN WATER

- We should realize a very simple fact, that if baptism in water saved you, then there was no purpose in the cross. Matt 3:14-15 baptism is an act of righteousness.
- Jesus never baptized in water because His baptism is in the Holy Spirit, a fire unquenchable.
- Water baptism is symbolic of God’s action of covering sin by the flood John 4:12

QUESTION SAMPLES

1. Do you believe Jesus took your sins on the cross and that God raised Him from the Dead?
2. Do you believe Jesus was the Son of God and the God raised Him from the Dead?
3. Do you believe Jesus is seated at the right hand of the Father and that God raised Him from the Dead?
4. Do you believe Jesus was God manifest in the flesh?
5. Do you believe Jesus was the sacrifice of God to cover our sins?

2nd Spot- How The Holy Spirit Teaches & Leads

- Romans 8:1 It is because of the lack of understanding of how the Holy Spirit teaches and leads that we as Christians have been missing the **corrections, teachings, and leadings** of the Holy Spirit.
- The mechanics: 1Cor 2:12-13 comparing spiritual things with spiritual.
- John 1:1-2 and John 1:14 “The Word” is referring to God and His Son but in other scriptures it means something said, including the thought like in John 15:20.

THERE IS ONLY ONE TRUTH

- The Holy Spirit is the only teacher who knows God’s thought behind His word. - Prov. 3:5
- 1Cor 2:6 specifically refers to the wisdom of this world coming to naught.
- To know God’s thought behind the scriptures or what He means requires revelation from the Holy Spirit.
- 1Cor 2:10 The word of God says the Holy Spirit reveals the deep things of God to us.
- 2Tim 2:15 we are to study and rightly divide the word of God.
- Isaiah 28:10 we are to add things together correctly - we must have the person who wrote the bible give us understanding and guidance as to how to rightly divide, add line upon line and precept upon precept.
- A man who cannot give witness to the things of the Spirit on the subject he is teaching was not taught by the Holy Spirit.
- Only what God meant will hold up.
- The pure and simple fact is that God gives a/the word and then the understanding, two separate things.

2nd Spot (cont'd)

- 1John 2:27 says “but as the same anointing teacheth you of all things.” The Holy Spirit teaches you about everything and you don’t really need man to teach you anything. But if the Body of Christ doesn’t know how the Holy Spirit teaches, it is being taught in the wisdom of men.
- Romans 8:5 a word, dream or a vision are things of the Spirit.
- One of the more miraculous things that can happen by following the “things of the Spirit” is deliverance, which comes because the Holy Spirit has revealed /taught truth.
- Acts 10:9-34 Peter had a revelation. Sometimes the Holy Spirit has to get our attention.
- If something suddenly strikes you as being simple, and it makes sense, it’s true.
- Romans 8:16 We should understand, that our spirit and God’s Spirit are not the same thing, although they both dwell in the Christian. Following the ‘things of the Spirit’ will enable you to differentiate between your human spirit and God’s Spirit.
- What should we do? Keep track, both individually and corporately of the “things of the Spirit.” Don’t throw anything away. What’s not of God will be found out. This is important because you don’t know what it is you don’t know or see. God does!
- Romans 8:6 & 7 It is important to pay attention to the “things of the Spirit” because the Spirit brings life by warning you, teaching you and leading you.

MECHANICS OF A FLOW CHART

- The existence of a flow chart allows a corporate body or an individual to walk in peace in the middle of a war!
- Romans 8:1 & 8:5-6 It really says there is no condemnation to Christians **who follow after the Spirit.**
- Following after the Spirit doesn’t mean you will get it right every time but it most certainly is true that if you keep following after the Spirit, you will eventually get the victory!

2nd Spot (cont'd)

- A flow chart will allow God to reveal things that you can't get any other way.
- We must remember the Holy Spirit is showing us what we don't know, not what we do know.
- Keeping a flow chart is the only way to separate God's spirit from our own.
- After you have had a flow chart for a while, it becomes a safety device.
- A flow chart is definitely a faith builder.
- A flow chart brings deeper understanding to a person that cannot be obtained any other way because the Holy Spirit teaches, comparing Spiritual with Spiritual. He is the one who searches the deep things of God! 1Cor 2:9-10.
- Holding yourself under the River means to keep your focus on what God has shown you until it cleanses away your thoughts that were contrary to His thoughts. It is a conscious choice a person must make.
- We must face the current, we must focus on the information that comes down the river.
- The "things of the Spirit" that come down the River are Rhema to us that produce **life to us**, both personally and corporately.

UNDERSTANDING THE MECHANICS OF A CORPORATE FLOW CHART

- Proverbs 4:13 Everything that comes down that River has a purpose.
 - Government comes down the River. His instruction to us comes down the River of Life. Remember, God's government is a theocracy, not a democracy.
- You must keep "self" out! It is pride for us to think that we could know anything not getting it from the Lord. Pride is the main problem in dealing with the "things of the Spirit", along with the lack of knowledge and understanding.

3rd Spot - Tithing

WHY DO THE GOOD ONES GO AND THE BAD ONES LIVE?

- Jesus walked in protection! He had a hedge, and it wasn't because He was God in the flesh. **It's a position God wants His Bride to come into.**

THE DISCIPLES KNEW HOW TO DELIVER THE LORD'S TREASURY

- We serve a King. The King of Kings. Jesus gave to the poor all the time and when a disciple delivered this wealth to a widow, the poor, or the oppressed they would say, "The Lord said to give this to you." They gave the Lord's wealth **in His name** because they believed He was a King.
 - If you, or a church, uses the King's treasury in your/its own name, who gets the credit? You, or the church, not the King you're supposed to be serving.
- John 20:27 Jesus let Thomas feel something tangible of Himself to help Thomas' unbelief.
 - Delivering the Lord's Treasury the right way opens doors that no other way can. It deals with unbelief.
- Every Kingdom does what it does in its own name, so if the church is to build the Lord's Kingdom, it must do it in the Lord's name, not their own. **We have ignorantly done things in our names instead of His. Who do we really love here?**
- When it comes to delivering the treasury of God the right way, we should get excited to see how the church can serve the Lord in a much fruitful way.

3rd Spot (cont'd)

WHAT DOES GOD SAY HIS TREASURY IS TO BE SPENT ON?

- He can only spend it on righteous purposes Psalm 145:17
- Matt 25:34-37 - Let's look at who Jesus called righteous. Jesus called these people righteous because of their acts, whether they had sinned in another areas of their life or not.
- Every act of righteousness is done directly to a person!
- Deut. 26:12 & 13 **We need to understand this fact: God doesn't consider tithing done until it is delivered to those He specified.**
- Acts 6:2-4 Honest report = they have already proved themselves honest by their past life.
 - Full of the Holy Ghost = The Holy Spirit provides wisdom and knowledge (insight) a person doesn't have on his own spirit in certain situations
- Read - Deut 26:12; 1Tim 5:16; Nehemiah 13:10; Nehemiah 12:47 (You should know that the early Christian Jews bought seats in the synagogue to pay for the building and its upkeep. They never used God's tithe for an unrighteous purpose.)
 - God built the temple with the wealth of Egypt not His tithe.
- God doesn't do things He tells us **not** to do.
- Matt 22:37-38 serving Him personally is loving Him personally.

3rd Spot (cont'd)

WHAT CHANGED AT THE CROSS WHEN IT COMES TO GOD'S TITHE?

- God loves His Son and the Bible says that He is exalted above everything in heaven. That's what changed. God is out to exalt His Son in the earth.

GIVE TO GOD - WHAT IS HAPPENING WHEN I DON'T GIVE MY TITHE OR, IN FAITH, GIVE IT TO A CHURCH THAT IS UNKNOWNLY SPENDING IT FOR HARLOTROUS PURPOSES?

- You are perpetuating harlotry and that makes you a part of the harlot.
- You are preventing God from being able to legally protect you and others. The result of doing these things results in the glory of the Lord being our rear guard, our hedge.
 - Job 29:12-17 Doing all of this had produced a hedge around Job.
 - You need someone to cover your backside.
- You are robbing God and you leave a wide open door into your backyard for the enemy to pass through at his will!
- The truth is simply: You are robbing God, man and nation and you are under a curse!
 - Curses are a result of disobedience and that these curses (Deut. 28:15) will happen to you if disobey.

3rd Spot (cont'd)

PARDON DEBT ...THE CURSE CAUSELESS SHALL NOT COME Proverb 26:1-2

- Malachi 3:8-9 But ye said, Wherein shall we return? Will a man rob God? Yet ye have robbed me. But ye say, Wherein have we robbed thee? In tithes and offerings. Ye are cursed with a curse: for ye robbed me, even this whole nation.
- Unholy altars are the churches who use God's money for unrighteous purposes.
- God doesn't consider tithing done until it is delivered to those He specified in His Word.
- It is no harder to hand over God's tithe to a church that is delivering it right, than it is to hand it over to a harlotrous church.
- Ask God what He will take to cover your back debt to Him produced by using His tithe for our own purposes. Satan uses this before God. God will give you an amount.
- Be sure not to steal again by seeing to it that your full tithe is used in the right way. It's time Christians closed some doors!
- Remember it is a process and not a snap of the finger.

THE LORD WANTS TO LEGALLY PROTECT HIS BRIDE!

- Read Malachi 3:9-11
 - The enemy comes in like a flood! God's hedge (that line of protection) had been holding back these identifiable types of attacks. Job 1:13-19

3rd Spot (cont'd)

- If we walk in covenant with God and follow after the “things of the spirit”, we would be protected supernaturally.
 - Luke 4:28; John 8:57 - 59; John 8:19 - 20 Jesus’ supernatural protection.
 - Jesus said no man could take His life unless He laid it down. Why? His Father’s covenant protection.
- The tithe is the Lord’s and when you deliver it, you have given nothing (cost you nothing because it is God’s and **never was yours**)! He entrusted you with it.
- God sometimes uses men to protect who He wants to protect. Acts 18:9 - 10.
- The Lord wants to protect the church from its enemy!
- The church in the world is unknowingly being held captive.
- God cannot protect His Bride (us) if she (we) is (are) robbing Him! No matter how much He loves her or she loves Him.

3rd Spot (cont'd)

GOD REVEALS THAT HIS PROTECTION IS MORE THAN I THOUGHT

- Even when you have on all the armor of God, you still cannot watch your backside! God is the only one who can! **The Lord is the only one who can protect us from satan and it is His Glory!** Isaiah 58:6-8. The result of doing these things correctly results in the glory of the Lord being our rear guard, our protection.
- God's precepts never end! **This is a promise!**
- **God is calling all of us (the church) out of harlotry because it is for our own good (Life)!**
- We can personally come into God's protection without warring and praying. As Christians we can't do warfare for our backsides.
- Isaiah 58:6-8 is a covenant promise. God says that if we will tithe correctly, He will protect our backsides. He hasn't been legally able to do His part because we haven't done our part.
- God is dealing with the heads of the families as they are responsible for their families' safety from the devil!

3rd Spot (cont'd)

GOD VERY SIMPLY DEMONSTRATES PROVERBS 26:1,2 – HIS PROTECTION FROM TROUBLES

- Prov. 26:1-2 a curse just doesn't come on its own. There is a reason it came.
- God can protect us in the matters of everyday life. It is time we believe Him! God gave us authority over the devices of the devil, but if we don't know and can't see his daily activities (our backsides) how can we come against what we don't know is going on? We must come into covenant on this important issue in order for Him to legally perform His part. He wants to protect us!

EXTRA, EXTRA, LADY FINDS SPIRITUAL REASON FOR MISHAP ON TURNPIKE

- You don't usually get to see what you were protected from.
- Satan doesn't want you under God's protection.

GOD ASKED ME, "ARE YOU HEALTHIER THAN YOU WERE A YEAR AGO?"

- Read Deut. 28:22, 27
- Jesus never got sick and this was not because He was God. He walked in the covenant that was established by God in the earth at that time.

3rd Spot (cont'd)

WHAT ABOUT OUR MINDS?

- Deut. 28:28 The covenant of better promises also had to include the promises of the old covenant or it wasn't better!
 - **Now, is it better for you to rebuke a fever or for God to keep it off you in the first place?**
- God is saying to us that if we will walk in covenant, which is to walk in the Word of the Lord's Kingdom, we can have all these protections He has shown us. The bottom line of walking in the invisible Kingdom of God is to handle the King's money correctly and not rob Him. Every government on the earth is established for its citizen's protection. But know this, there is no government on earth that can protect a citizen when they are breaking the laws of that country by committing robbery.
- Paul said we as Christians establish the laws of God. We establish God's Word in the earth. God **wants to protect** us in the spirit realm!
- **We can not be in covenant with God if we are robbing Him. That's what getting married to the Lord is, coming into complete covenant with Him in every area of His Word.**

3rd Spot (cont'd)

MALACHI 3 PROPHETIC TO OUR TIME, OR THE HARD PART!

- Malachi 3:1-17 The church needs to quit robbing God and then God will change this nation.
- Have you ever wondered why the wealth of the wicked has not arrived into the hands of the righteous? The answer is **the church must work righteousness in order to be righteous.**
- It's not what He has called the church to do with His money that is hard. If you walked into a church that was handling the Lord's money righteously, **it wouldn't be hard for you at all!** It's admitting and dealing with the problem of changing that is hard. Getting rid of our old ways is what's hard.!

3rd Spot (cont'd)

I SAW A MAN OF SILVER, IMMACULATE IN NATURE

- God tells us to choose His way of doing something. His Ways are the right ways. When Christians say they are not under the Law, they are saying they are not under the right ways to do things; they can do whatever they want. The truth is when we break the Laws of God, like the law of the tithe, we get under them, are subject to them, and become open bait for the enemy.
- Haven't You Heard Of Combining Healing And The Law?
 - Tithing correctly or seeing that your tithe gets to the right places will protect you from cancer.
 - Ezekiel 33:12-16 verse 15 states **statutes of life** is translated as "**laws that give life.**"
- God tell us to renew our minds after we are saved. Why? Romans 8:7 - God wants us to learn and walk in the righteousness of the laws of God.
 - Those laws and statutes are the ones God says He will write on our hearts under the new covenant. Heb. 8:8-10.

3rd Spot (cont'd)

JESUS DEALT WITH THE DEVIL, WITH “IT IS WRITTEN!”

- Jesus showed us “the way” while He was here. **He is the Way**, the Truth, the Life. God wants to be able to say to the devil on your behalf, “It is written that (Name) has paid their back debt and they have not robbed Me since. Satan, get thee hence!”
- Delivering God’s tithe and offerings correctly is one of the greatest and most exciting things one can experience as a worker for Christ!
- Learn to give without strings attached.
- Enter into it with the attitude of learning.
- Let Him work by delivering it in His name.
- Say or write, “The Lord said to give this to you.”

WILL YOU TRUST ME?

- We should understand that the main motive for tithing correctly is **because we Love Him** according to His first commandment.
- Second motive is for protections.

3rd Spot (cont'd)

GOD GIVES AN INSIGHT: TITHE – GIFTS

- You can give an offering anywhere, to any organization, a project, or a church as you wish, but to give an offering to the Lord it must go to the same place as the tithe.
- An offering is above the tithe and is found in Matt 25:40.

TITHING BASICS

- A tithe is 10% based on your gross income, except for when you run a business. You tithe on the net income of your business, not considering depreciation.
- You do not have to tithe on a gift you receive unless you want to.
- The Lord's tithe is delivered to a person. It can go through a ministry if they deliver 100% of it to a person. It is best if they have a special account for the Lord's Treasury.
- Tithes goes to:
 1. the needy, the widow (that the family is not taking care of);
 2. the fatherless (this includes a woman where the husband/father has left the family and she is struggling);
 3. the stranger;
 4. the Psalmist;
 5. The five fold men/women of God (just because they have a label doesn't mean they fulfill this requirement)
