But some said, Shall Christ come out of Galilee? 42 Hath not the scripture said, That Christ cometh of the seed of David, and out of the town of Bethlehem, where David was? 43 So there was a division among the people because of him.... 45 Then came the officers to the chief priests and Pharisees; and they said unto them, Why have ye not brought him? 46 The officers answered, Never man spake like this man. 47 Then answered them the Pharisees, Are ye also deceived? 48 Have any of the rulers or of the Pharisees*

*believed on him? **49** But this people who knoweth not the law are cursed.  
**50** Nicodemus saith unto them, (he that came to Jesus by night, being one of them,)  
**51** Doth our law judge any man, before it hear him, and know what he doeth?  
**52** They answered and said unto him, Art thou also of Galilee? Search, and look: for out of Galilee ariseth no prophet.*

***45** Philip findeth Nathanael, and saith unto him, We have found him, of whom Moses in the law, and the prophets, did write, Jesus of Nazareth, the son of Joseph. **46** And Nathanael said unto him, Can there any good thing come out of Nazareth? Philip saith unto him, Come and see.*
